

The organisers and all organizations and individuals who are employed by or associated with it, in connection with this Exhibition, will not assume responsibility and shall be held harmless by all Exhibitors for damage or loss resulting from fire, theft, or any other cause whatsoever, including accident or injury to exhibitors, their employees and agents, the public, or others. The Exhibitor agrees to pay promptly for any and all damages to the exhibition building or its equipment incurred through carelessness or otherwise, of Exhibitor or its employees or agents.

made in writing and forwarded to the organisers at corne@savetcon.co.za. Cancellations or space reductions will be subject to charges according to the following schedule:

- More than 60 days and less than three months before event start date – deposit forfeited; excess of deposit paid will be refunded less 20% administration fee.
- 60 days and less before event start date full amount shall be forfeited. In the event of cancellation or reduction of contracted space, and subject to the above cancellation charges schedule, the organisers shall retain the right to resell cancelled space without rebate or allowance to the Exhibitor.
